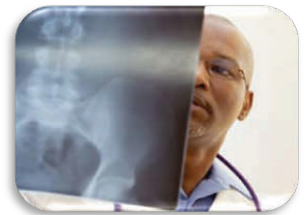

# ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Targeted classroom and on-the-job training designed to provide you with the tools and credentials you need to gain employment in the Healthcare industry. The areas of focus are Healthcare Information Technology, Acute Healthcare and Long-term Healthcare. Financial assistance is available, based on eligibility.

## ► Healthcare INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

Healthcare Information Technology is “the application of information processing involving both computer hardware and software that deals with the storage, retrieval, sharing, and use of health care information, data, and knowledge for communication and decision making” (Brailer, & Thompson, 2004). The technology can represent computers and communications attributes that can be networked to build systems for moving health information. Many positions are in administration, management, insurance, procedures and overall technology.

## ► ACUTE HEALTHCARE:

Acute care is provided by professionals who assist in the treatment of abrupt onset illness or condition or disease. Acute often also can describe an illness that is of short duration, rapidly progressive, and in need of urgent care.

The Acute care initiative was designed to train individuals interested in becoming registered nurses and entry-level health care workers, as well as enhance critical skills for incumbent nurses, allied health professionals and nurse educators.

## ► LONG-TERM HEALTHCARE

Healthcare professionals provide rehabilitative, restorative, and/or ongoing skilled nursing care to patients or residents in need of assistance with activities of daily living. Nursing facilities, assisted living and/or life care residences, and homes for people with special needs or developmental disabilities need round-the-clock experienced nursing care, whether it be a Certified Nursing Assistant, Resident Assistant, Therapists, Home/Hospice Care Management, Administrative or Food Service, all positions hold a key role in long-term environments.

# Frequently Asked Questions...

## If I want to participate in a Healthcare Training program, what should I do first?

All Career Center Members are encouraged to attend the *Healthcare Career Exploration* workshop (Times and locations may be found on the lower left panel of this brochure). The workshop is held once-a-week, during a scheduled time at a Career Center location near you (see back panel for the workshop schedule). If you are not a Career Center Member you can the 15-minute Career Center *Overview*, held daily at all locations.

## Are there eligibility requirements for this program?

First, the GKC HITT job training program is unique in that there are **NO INCOME REQUIREMENTS**. Applicants must be unemployed and not currently enrolled in school or in another job training program; at least 18 years old, and have earned a high school diploma or GED. Applicants must also be a resident of Missouri or Kansas, and currently living one of the following counties: Jackson, Clay, Platte, Ray or Cass (Missouri) or Johnson, Leavenworth or Wyandotte (Kansas).

## What types of Healthcare training programs does the grant fund?

Acute Care occupations (hospitals – nurses, surgical technicians, etc.); Long-term Care (nursing homes, long term care hospitals – registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, insulin certifications, etc.); and Healthcare Information Technology (not medical billing and coding) are *examples* of approved training offered in conjunction with this grant.
