1. *Has the FEC designated a location (s) where the trainings will be held, or will that be the responsibility of the Contractor?*

2. *Can you please specify the OSHA training-general industry or construction?*

General Industry.

3. *Is the supervisory staff included with the 225 trainees?*

Yes.

4. *Would you like for the supervisors to have a 30 hour certification-typical for supervisory staff?*

Supervisory staff will receive at a minimum OSHA-10 Certification.

5. *What exactly is FEC's vision for the program?*

To provide young adults with job specific skills by a recognized educational institution through award of a credential/certificate, (Retrofit Service Representative Training, that will provide them greater opportunities to be placed into employment when the training/outreach effort is concluded; to provide young adults with relevant skills in the green jobs industry that will give them greater likelihood to be placed into this industry; to be conversant in energy retrofit programs funded through the city of KCMO so that area residents will better understand these and therefore be more inclined to use them; to undertake an extensive community outreach effort through the City of KCMO and the Full Employment Council to promote energy retrofit programs to targeted neighborhoods that have not full taken advantage of them.
