# Learn to Earn—Application Process

**Objective:** To provide economically disadvantaged young adults, 18-24 years old, with internships/scholarships in occupations that support professional baseball and football athletics.

**Program Design:** Participants will be provided a six-week internship and receive up to \$3,000 in scholarships to attend a community college or vocational school. Participants may complete internships and attend post-secondary classes simultaneously. Woman and minorities are encouraged to apply.

**Funded By:** Kansas City Chiefs football team, Kansas City Royals baseball team and the Full Employment Council (FEC) in support of the Jackson County Sports Complex Fair Share Agreement.

## Who Can Participate (Individuals must meet all criteria):

- Youth ages 18—24 years old
- High school graduates/ HiSET certificate—(Copy of HS diploma or HiSET certificate is required)
- Jackson County residents - (Proof of residency will be required, e.g. Missouri ID, driver's license etc.)
- Working phone number—(If accepted, you will be notified by phone)
- Social Security Card – (FEC participates in the E-Verify system; all participant applications will be verified with the US Department of Homeland Security)
- Economically Disadvantaged—Must submit proof of income (up to 200% of poverty based on federal HHS guidelines)

## How to Apply: Scholarships are limited, this is a competitive process!

1. Complete the 'Learn to Earn' application in its entirety and submit to the Full Employment Council
2. Must score at least ninth grade reading, language and math levels. (Screening/testing to be completed by FEC)
3. Must complete and pass background check (required)
4. Participate in a panel interview regarding your interest in the program. The panel will render a final decision and FEC will contact you by phone and letter if selected for the program.
5. Individuals selected must adhere to the FEC 'Code of Conduct' regarding dress, worksite behavior, classroom behavior and attendance.
