THE CRITERIA AND TERMS FOR CLASSROOM OCCUPATIONAL SKILL TRAINING WILL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- Customer will utilize <https://jobs.mo.gov/> to identify WIOA eligible training provider, using the search fields at <https://scorecard.mo.gov/>
- Training must be in an in-demand occupation, as identified by the Missouri Economic Research and Information Center (MERIC) <https://meric.mo.gov/> and current economic conditions.
- Certificate program and/or tuition assistance must be 12-months or less and must result in a diploma, degree, or certification, and must lead to fulltime employment
- Eligibility will be determined by assessment tools: the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) or Workkeys (if you have passed an assessment(s) without need for prerequisites, your score may be considered a substitute for taking TABE)
- Customer will attend classroom occupational skill training fulltime, if not employed
- Customer must agree to provide monthly updates regarding progress in the form of a Career Center visit, email, or phone call
- Customer will provide the Full Employment Council with a copy of the certificate, upon completion of the program
- The costs of prerequisite courses for classroom occupational training are not funded and therefore must be paid for by the individual
- Master's degree programs are not funded

Please note: As a participant of the Workforce 21 Scholarship program, you are required to communicate with staff of the Full Employment Council/Missouri Career Center as needed. Your information and/or feedback will remain confidential, and will be used for sole use by the Full Employment Council/Missouri Career Center, as well as the U.S. Department of Labor. In addition, you will also be required to participate in all surveys and answer any questions, in relation to your employment status, wage gains, or other employment training information, as your feedback will assist in determining the effectiveness of the program.
